Most African countries require Environmental Assessments (EAs) to be conducted for major projects prior to their approval.

Developers must commission EA studies as part of their planning. Independent consultants usually do the work.

However, many consultants are not EA experts, having originally trained as sociologists, ecologists, hydrologists, archaeologists, land use planners or some other discipline. Similarly, government officials and developers are often unfamiliar with EA: a process that is a *dynamic mixture of disciplines*; a combination of science, art, politics and governance.

Inadequate knowledge of EA often leads to confusion, poor quality work, contradictory expectations, frustration and sometimes, to unnecessary conflicts.

Concepts such as scoping, screening, public participation, impacts and mitigation, the precautionary and preventative principles, the *no net loss rule* and *opportunity costs* need to be well understood.

This course will help emerging EA practitioners, developers, regulators, NGOs and other decision makers to understand EA processes and to appreciate the value of EA as a Sustainable Development tool.
